




The Knights of Columbus Council 11878 will be collecting baby bottles, baby diapers,




This Sunday, April 21st, is Good Shepherd Sunday and the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.

This commemoration is an opportunity to pray for and promote vocations to consecrated and ordained life

Our next meeting has changed to Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 5:30 pm.




