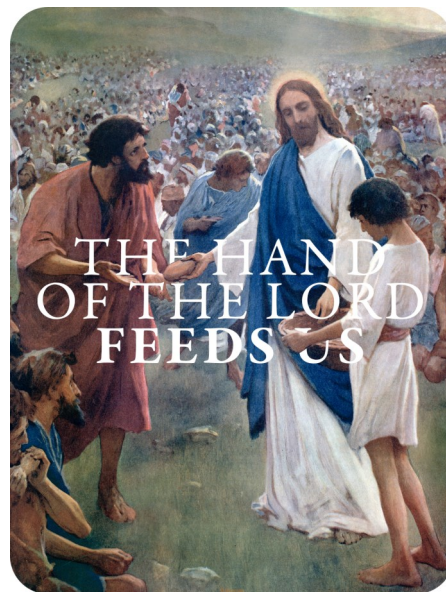

Each year, the Diocesan Council of
