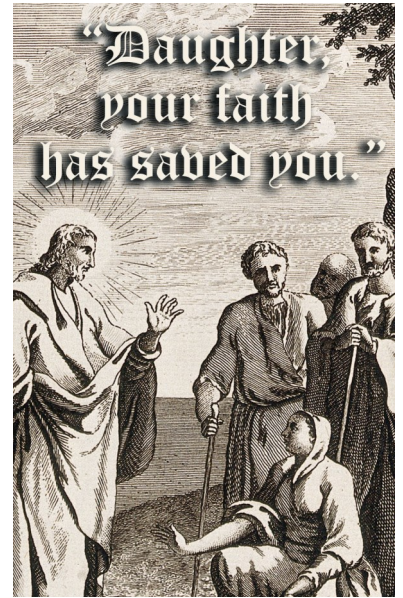

## Religious Education Program

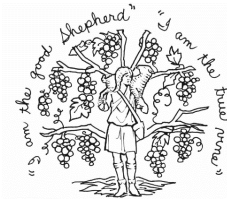
Thank you to all who came and helped with our 2023-2024 Religious Education Program for 3 years old through elementary and middle, plus our high school youth group.

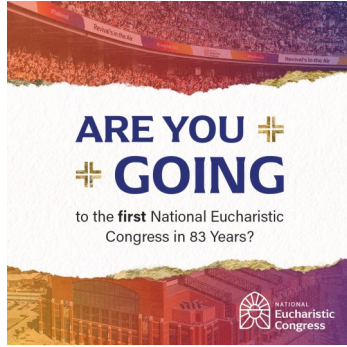
